

Son of Noted Engineer Has Leg Severed

The son of one of the builders of the famous Moffatt tunnel, in Colorado, is confined at the Boulder City hospital, following the amputation of his right leg just above the ankle, Wednesday. The man's name is John Tinkler, and not Gass, as was stated in yesterday's paper. Tinkler's father was

a member of the firm of Tinkler & Hitchcock, contractors, who built the tunnel.

Tinkler was injured when his leg was struck by a rock falling over 200 feet and crushing the member so badly that amputation was found necessary. He was employed as a jackhammer man at the dam.

Tinkler, who is 28 years old, came to Boulder City from California, and his wife, notified of his injury, arrived yesterday to be at his bedside.
