

RESERVATION ADMISSION RULE EFFECTIVE FIRST

Badges Insufficient, Be-
ginning June 1 Lights
Will Be Inspected

A new and more strict code for admission to the Hoover dam reservation will be put into effect commencing June 1, according to Police Chief Glen E. Bodell.

Men have been just showing badges at the gate, but in the future this will not be enough, they will have to display passes also, Bodell said, and all other people must have passes.

Reservation police at the gate will inspect all cars for head lights. They have insisted that the lights be in good shape and have dimmers. On the reservation only dimmers may be used. The rangers at the gate have said that they will have a strict enforcement of this rule and people with defective lights will not be allowed to enter the reservation.

The strict enforcement of this rule will begin tomorrow.
