

Man Rock Killed Had Assumed Name

"James Roberts," who was killed on the dam project this week, was working on the dam under an assumed name, in order to avoid detection by emigration authorities, it has been revealed.

He was a native of Canada, and his true name was James L. Millay. He was 37 and a widower. He had gone by another assumed name, "J. R. Mays."

His father-in-law, reached by wire has been unable to locate any relatives.

Millay was killed in the Nevada spillway when a falling rock crushed his skull.
