

Baker Died Of Heart Trouble

Death of Frank Dean Baker, 39, died of heart failure, "embolism," according to the finding of the coronor's jury last night hearing the inquest on the death of the man yesterday at 9 a. m. when he suddenly slumped over as he walked across the cofferdam workings and died.

The hearing was held at 4 p. m. yesterday.

The body will be sent east, arrangements having been made by relatives in Virginia.

Baker was the stepson of John W. Craddock, chairman of the board of directors of the Craddock-Terry Show company, of Lynchburg, Virginia.
