

LANDSCAPING OF BOULDER CITY TO BE BEGUN SOON

~~2000~~ ²⁰³² Shade Trees Are to be Placed Along Streets in Near Future

~~2000~~ Two hundred shade trees will line the streets of Boulder City in a very short time, according to the plan of Wilbur W. Weed, chief landscape gardner for the government project.

Extensive shrubbery will be planted around the dormitories, administration buildings, and municipal buildings.

THE PLAN of gardens also includes the four plazas of the city. Two of these plazas will transformed into formal rose gardens with rose shrubs, as the main feature of the gardens, following a geometrical design. The other two plazas will also be rose gardens but will follow a more informal line, and will be interspersed with other flowering plants.

The homes of the government employes will be landscaped under the supervision of Weed, and lawns and gardens set in. Lawns will also be set around all of the government buildings, and extensive sprinkler systems installed.

THE PLANS for landscaping have not been fully completed, but work is going to be started soon in setting out the shade trees and in the planting of gardens.

AIDING IN BEAUTIFYING Boulder City the Six Companies have offered \$25 a month to be given to the best kept house and yard. The first prizes will be awarded March 10, for the month of February and will consist of \$15 for the first and \$10 for the second. The prizes will be awarded each month by three women judges.

Residents of Boulder City have already begun to improve their yards by planting desert plants and shrubbery.

WITH THE EFFORTS of the government landscaping and the Six Companies incentive Boulder City will become a model of attractive homes and gardens.
