

Pheland Is Still

At Liberty Today

Tom Pheland, former deputy sheriff, for whom a warrant was issued early yesterday afternoon, charging assault with a deadly weapon with intent to do great bodily harm, was still at liberty today, no arrest having been made as yet.

Pheland was scheduled to be brought into the justice court to be placed under bond, and was still in the city today, according to reports.

The issuance of the warrants was the outgrowth of an alleged assault on Claude Williams, chief ranger in the Boulder Dam reservation who was struck over the head with a gun, assertedly wielded by Pheland, and seriously injured.

Williams suffered a concussion of the brain, and a hemorrhage which left his eyes crossed, whether temporarily or permanently had not yet been determined.
