

Feland Case Is Dismissed Today

The charge of assault with intent to do great bodily injury to Claude Williams, ranger at the reservation at the river, was dismissed this morning on motion of the state. The state pleaded that there was insufficient evidence and that the complaining witness had failed to aid in the prosecution.
