

# Truckster Misses Death in Plunge

Boulder Dam workmen are telling the story of the miraculous escape last week of a truck driver known only as "Red," who backed his truck over a 300 foot embankment at the Nevada spillway workings, and after catapaulting into the canyon, landed right side up on all four wheels, slightly dazed but able to drive the truck out under its own power.

The truck had been at work hauling away the first excavated from the workings, and the driver, in backing away over the usual road failed to turn sharply enough to make the curve in the highway.

The big truck, load and all, went over the bank, turned over several times and landed on its wheels at the bottom.

The cab was crushed, somewhat, but otherwise the truck was not damaged "Red" himself was shaken up and dazed, but in as good shape as his truck.
