

Tuition Free Revealed By Ely Today

How Many Classes in New Institution Will Be De- cided Monday

High school classes for Boulder City, and without tuition!

It is definitely determined there will be several grades of high school instruction in the reservation community.

How many grades there will be is not yet known, but will be determined after a meeting of parents next Monday evening.

At least two grades of high school, however, definitely will be started on October 10, a week from next Monday, according to announcement made today by City Manager Sims Ely.

Parents of students of all four high school grades in Boulder City are urged by Ely to attend the meeting Monday evening at 7:30 in the Municipal building auditorium, whether their children are attending school in Las Vegas or not. For the plans for classes will be made on the basis of the number of children represented in the various grades.

Some parents have strongly urged that all four grades of high school be carried, but the practicability of this is not yet determined.

There will be junior high school, at least, including eighth, ninth and tenth grades, and children may count on those grades, for instruction in the fundamental high school subjects and as wide a selection of subjects as will be possible with the number of teachers to be employed.

The students will have to furnish their own books and stationery, though arrangements have been made for payment of salaries without the need for government or parents to pay on this phase of school maintenance.

The classes will be in the new Boulder school building, which was built by and is maintained by the government.

Six Companies Inc. is paying salaries for eleven elementary teachers.
