

STREET WORK FOR BOULDER CITY'S NEWEST SUBDIVISION IS STARTED BY NEW MEXICO CONSTRUCTION CO.

Contractors Start Trenching, Grading for Sewers,
Water Mains in Southeast Corner Where Six
Companies Building 250 New Homes

Building of streets for Boulder City's newest "subdivision" was started this week by the New Mexico Construction company, in order that the 250 new homes being built by Six Companies Inc. in the southeast section of town shall have streets, water mains and sewers.

Beginning on digging of trenches for water and sewer mains first, the company which graded streets for the whole of the community will concentrate first on these mains, grading and preparing the streets for traffic later.

Notice to proceed is awaited from Washington, D. C., the Boulder City office of the Bureau of reclamation having sent its recommendations. The contractors are going ahead before receiving notice to proceed, in order to save time.

In addition to the portion of the community to be used by Six Companies, there is included in this project part of the territory to be occupied by private homes to be erected by individuals.

Government surveyors have completed the laying out of the streets for the new sector.
