

Government's New Dormitory Is Done

The new 34-man dormitory of the Bureau of Reclamation in Boulder City was completed yesterday by the De Camp Hudson company, contractors, and soon will be ready for occupancy by government employes.

The structure, located across the court to the east of the municipal building, was started this spring, and rushed to early completion, in order to aid in caring for the government men who thus far have had to continue living outside of Boulder City, and in the original government camp in Hemenway wash.

The building faces east, and has two stories.
