

NEW RESIDENCE SECTIONS TO BE BUILT TO HOUSE FOLK IN BOULDER

280 New Homes to Bring
Total Up to About 800
In Few Months, Said

Two new residential sections totaling 280 more homes will be added to Boulder City's housing facilities immediately, to make it possible for workers to comply with the bureau of reclamation order that all temporary camp homes on the reservation outside Boulder City must be abandoned by April 1.

Bureau of reclamation officials today announced the government will build another dormitory and 30 small homes, in addition to 250 small houses to be constructed by Six Companies Inc.

Six Companies will build its additional block of homes, for use by its employes only, and employes of sub-contractors, to the south of the present company home district.

Plans for this addition, in relation to sewerage drainage and streets, are being worked out by government engineers, and two to four more east-west streets will be built south of Fifth. The territory to the east of the rows also probably will be devoted to Six Company residences.

The government homes will be constructed to the south of the hospital, for the most part, and a section south of the hospital and on both sides of Utah street probably will be set aside for lease for private home construction.

The New Mexico Construction company will be given a supplementary order immediately to go ahead with construction of sewers, water mains and streets for the new sector.

The government homes probably will cost around \$800 to \$950 each, having two and three rooms.

With Six Companies employes now occupying 415 homes and with 70 government homes completed and under construction, addition of 280 more will bring the total to 765. Assuming that about 35 or more other homes will be built, the total should reach 800 within a few months, it is anticipated.

Government engineers are moving into the new dormitory of the bureau of reclamation from the

government camp, which will be occupied mainly by landscaping workers who soon will be employed for improving and beautifying the community.

The new dormitory for government employes will be located on Colorado street to the west of Nevada, a short distance west of the new Boulder City Motors building.

Outside individuals not employed by the government or the contractors may get full information relative to leasing ground at a nominal rate and erecting homes thereon in Boulder City, by calling at the office of City Manager Sims Ely, which office will be in the Beckley building in Las Vegas until it is moved to the municipal building in Boulder March first.
