

# C of C Party to Go to Salt Lake

Leaving Las Vegas for Salt Lake City sometime Friday, representatives of the chamber of commerce are planning on a complete presentation of the attractions of Las Vegas and vicinity and the Boulder dam area as a major scenic trip, to the representatives of the chambers of commerce of the intermountain area gathered for the purpose of outlining plans to secure for this district the full quota of the hundreds of thousands who are expected to visit Los Angeles during the Olympic Games this spring and summer.

A special pamphlet has been printed for distribution among the visitors to the conference and in the towns along the way, and copies of the Progress edition of the Review-Journal will also be passed around to all interested. A special display of photographs showing the progress of the Boulder Canyon project has been arranged, and will repose in the lobby of the Newhouse hotel during the conference.

President J. H. Down and Secretary Nye Wilson of the chamber will make the trip together with A. C. Grant, chairman of the national parks committee and A. R. Thompson, head of the highway committee.
