

# 9,135 VOTERS QUALIFY FOR 1932 ELECTION

Las Vegas, With 10 Precincts Shows 5,112 Electors, 3,567 are Demos

A total of 9,135 residents of Clark county have qualified to vote at the coming general election so far, it was announced this morning by County Clerk Wm. L. Scott, and with ten days remaining for additional registrations, this county will step high into second position among the counties of the state with more than 10,000 voters, or almost one fourth of the entire number qualified.

The city of Las Vegas, with ten precincts shows 5,112 qualified electors, with the democrats holding an advantage of 3,567 to 1,226 republicans and 319 non-partisans.

**BOULDER CITY'S** total has climbed well above the 2,000 mark with 2,378 registrations of which 1828 are democrats, 370 republicans and 180 non-partisan voters.

The rest of the county shows 1,084 democrats, 425 republicans and 136 non-partisans, bringing the county totals to 6,479 democrats, 2021 republicans and 635 non-partisans, giving the democrats a better than three to one margin in the entire registration.

**WHILE SCOTT** predicts the total will go well over the 10,000 mark, he anticipates that the ratios of parties will remain about the same.
