

Youths Arrested At Boulder Dam

Two boys, Frederick F. Carstens, Jr., and Norman J. Stewart, Jr., who were picked up by Boulder City rangers at Boulder dam and were driving a stolen car, were removed from the Boulder City jail to Las Vegas by the United States marshal, according to the report of officers.

The boys, who are 16 and 17 years old, had escaped from the reformatory at Ione, California, had stolen cars both at Jackson and Pine Grove, California, and had robbed a drive-in stand in Phoenix, Arizona, officers said.

According to Chief Ranger C. F. Peterson, the boys probably will face charges of violating the Dyer act, for allegedly transporting a stolen car across a state line.
