

BOULDER PHONE EXCHANGE NOW BEING INSTALLED

Building Moved to Corner Of Ash and Arizona for Switchboards

With an exchange station being established, Boulder City's telephone system is on the verge of expansion into a service which will be capable of rendering phone service on a much broader basis for the Hoover Dam community.

Two switchboards are being installed in a building which last evening was moved for the purpose to the future Boulder "home" of the Southern Nevada Telephone company, at Arizona and Ash street, and service from this point will be commenced in the very near future, it is planned.

The building is one formerly occupied as a schoolroom on Avenue B near New Mexico street. The structure was moved by truck yesterday and today was being shunted from the street over on to the lot, where it will be connected up with wires and switchboards installed.

The switchboards are on hand in Boulder City, and ready for installation.

It is expected many business firms and homes which have not had phone service hithertofore will have the service soon.

The Six Company switchboard, for Six Company offices, will be maintained in the office, it is understood.
