

# VARIOUS FIRMS IN BIG SIX TO GO OVER PLANS IN THIS CITY

Felix Kahn, Treasurer, is First Here, Vegas to Be Center of Work.

## OTHERS EN ROUTE

Will Complete Organization and Map Out Program of Work.

Las Vegas and Boulder City will be centers for employment of men and for purchasing of materials for construction of the Boulder Canyon dam, according to Felix Kahn, treasurer of Six Companies, Inc., who arrived in his city this morning by plane for a week's conference of officials of the company which is now beginning the great job of building the dam.



To confer with the men who will have charge actually at the scene of activity, headed by Superintendent Frank T. Crowe, directors and consultants of the contracting firm are in Las Vegas, for the major part of the week to complete the details of organizing the project and to outline the construction program.

W. A. Bechtel, one of the board of directors of the company, is expected to arrive early next week or late this week from San Francisco.

K. K. BECHTEL, assistant treasurer and assistant secretary to Six Companies, Inc., and son of W. A. Bechtel, arrived this morning by plane with Kahn, and S. D. Bechtel, also son of W. A. Bechtel, and also connected with the company, was expected to arrive today.

G. G. Sherwood of Oakland, temporarily office manager for Six Companies, Inc., in San Francisco, is one of the party which arrived this morning for the conference of the week.

Charles Shea, member of one of the firms which comprise Six Companies, Inc., also was expected to arrive today for the week's conference.

FELIX KAHN, who is a member of the firm of McDonald and Kahn of San Francisco, stated this morning that he and others of the directors plan to divide their time between their own offices and the scene of activity in Southern Nevada, making the trip here, largely by plane, every week or so. Thus will close contact be maintained between the directors and the men in charge of the actual work.
