

Olympic Village Being "Moved to Boulder City"

Part of the famous "Olympic Village" is being moved to Boulder City!

It will help materially to solve the acute housing problem in the Hoover dam construction community.

Twenty or thirty of the small houses in which the world's greatest athletes lived during the recent Olympiad in Los Angeles now will house men building the greatest dam in the world.

They are being hauled to Boulder, "knocked down," by the truckload, and are being erected by L. S. Henderson, contractor, in the vicinity south of Nevada boulevard and east of the football field.

The homes have two main rooms and bath, and though they are small, they will make it possible for many to live in Boulder City by renting them instead of traveling afar each day.

Three of the homes had been erected last evening.
