
Bishop is Absolved Of Blame in Crash

Bishop Thomas Jenkins was absolved of any blame by the coroner's jury investigating the death of O. J. Patterson, Boulder dam worker, who was killed last Saturday night after being struck by the Jenkins car on the Boulder City highway a half mile from the reservation gates.

The verdict of the jury was returned this morning, according to Coroner Frank M. Ryan, and the findings were to the effect that Patterson was drunk at the time, and staggered across the highway directly in the path of the Jenkins car.
