

# WOMAN SEEKING VEGAS DIVORCE LANDS IN JAIL

## Charge of Contributing to Delinquency of Minor Faces Mrs. A. S. Bender

Mrs. A. S. Bender, in Las Vegas for the purpose of securing a divorce from her husband, ran afoul of the law last Sunday and as a result is in the county jail, charged with contributing to the delinquency of a minor. Her trial will be held before Justice of the Peace Frank Ryan at seven o'clock tonight.

According to the juvenile officer and the Boulder City police, who worked together on the case, the woman is said to have left one of the Las Vegas dance halls Friday night in the company of a 13 year old girl. Dancehall officers declare that they were both drunk at the time.

FOR TWO days and two nights the pair finally ending up in the recreation hall at Boulder City. The mother of the girl, who did not know Mrs. Bender, was frantic and had the juvenile officer and police hunting the missing pair.

Boulder City police, who were on the lookout for the couple, accosted them in the hall where Mrs. Bender was said to be soliciting. They were both placed under arrest and lodged in the Boulder City jail and transferred to Las Vegas where the woman was incarcerated and the girl turned over to her mother and placed on probation.

YESTERDAY A complaint was sworn out by the mother of the girl and Mrs. Bender was arraigned yesterday afternoon. She pleaded not guilty to the charge, denying most of the allegations, and trial was set for this evening.
