

Amador Hearing Is Held This Morning

Jose Amador, charged with first degree murder as a result of his alleged stabbing of Juan Costello two weeks ago, had his preliminary hearing in the justice court this morning.

The state produced four witnesses, Juan Rodriguez, William E. Mott and Dr. Herzig, who outlined a very simple case, telling that the two men, the deceased, and the defendant, had apparently engaged in a fight on the Westside, that Amador had stabbed Costello and then fled to Wann, where he was captured. Dr. Herzig testified as to the cause of death.

The testimony in the case will be read back to the witnesses either tomorrow or Saturday.
