

3 "COMMUNITY" GARAGES TO BE BUILT BY U. S.

Structures Will House
Autos of 44 Bureau of
Reclamation Men

Large community garages are an innovation which will be put into use in Boulder City by the government

For three community garages to house a total of 44 automobiles for employees of the bureau of reclamation will be built in the near future, the largest to be capable of sheltering 20 machines, the others 12 each.

Bids for the job will be opened at 10 a. m. March 10 in Boulder City or Las Vegas.

The buildings will be one story in height, with concrete foundations, with hollow brick walls and partitions, concrete floors and asphalt composition single roofs.

Ninety days will be allowed for construction.

The largest of the buildings will be located in Block 9, between Denver and Colorado streets. Another will be in Block 7, between Utah and Park streets, west of the hospital.

The largest will be built with six rooms, four capable of housing four cars each, and two to house two each. A separate door will give egress to each machine, doors being along both of the long sides of the building.
