

Liquor In Gulch Puts Man in Jail

Ray Willard, Hoover dam employee, is being detained in the Clark county jail because he hid, according to reservation police, liquor in a gulch at the side of the road above the machine shop in Boulder City.

Reservation police found the deposit of liquor and lay in wait for the owner to come. Willard arrived and with him was another man. He admitted the ownership, according to the officers, of the liquor and was placed under arrest.

Willard was arraigned before United States Commissioner W. J. Flowers yesterday afternoon on the charge of possession of liquor. Bond was set at \$500. Willard was unable to make bond and is being held to appear before the United States district court.
