

New School On West Side Opened

In a new frame structure built by her brother adjoining his residence, Mrs. Anna Bissell this week opened school with 16 pupils across the railroad track from the New Mexico construction camp.

Saving children of the vicinity the trip over to the other school group at New Mexico street and Avenue B, Mrs. Bissell is teaching children from the entire west end of town.

She is living with her brother, Charlie Elder, Six Companies carpenter, who built the "annex" to his home in order that she might have a place to open her private school.

The school is well lighted and heated, and according to the general rules for construction and lighting of rural small schools. It is 12 by 16 feet in size.

Mrs. Bissell is a widow. She has taught previously in California and Oregon. School opened Monday in her new school house.
