

Bodell Confirms

Resignation Tale

Confirming the rumor that he has resigned from his position as chief ranger, or police chief on the Hoover dam reservation, Glen E. "Bud" Bodell late yesterday stated the resignation is to take effect as soon as is convenient for the officials of the bureau of reclamation to whom he is responsible.

His resignation, it is explained was submitted in order to make it possible for him to accept a position as chief special agent for Six Companies Inc. He will receive also a deputy sheriff's commission for service in Clark county, it is planned.

"I wish to state that my association here as chief ranger have been very pleasant and that I highly appreciate the support I have received from my superiors in policing the Boulder canyon project," Bodell stated in his letter of resignation.

"Mr. Bodell is a fine and capable officer, and has done a splendid job of policing the reservation and Boulder City," said City Manager Sims Ely, in commenting upon the resignation of Chief Bodell. "It is with regret that I learn of Mr. Bodell's action, which is entirely voluntary on his part."
