

# Dam Worker Dies In Plunge Today

Pete Savoff, 44, powder-man for Six Companies, plunged to instant death this morning, when he fell off the edge of the cliff at the inspection adit on the Nevada side, and dropped 250 feet to the canyon below.

The doomed man fell head foremost and death resulted from a fractured skull, doctors said. Death was instantaneous, it was reported.

While there were four or five witnesses to Savoff's fatal plunge none could explain how his fall started. An inquest will be held tonight at seven o'clock, with Frank M. Ryan, coroner, in charge.

Savoff was single and had relatives in Seattle, Washington, who were notified.
