

# Power Firm Sets A Record, Revealed

The Southern Sierras Power company, supplying power to Boulder City and the Boulder dam project, has established a record which, according to company engineers, is without precedent in the annals of power transmission. Without interruption to service and with no accidents, a crew consisting of two linemen and two groundmen has just completed a three month job of installing three thousand "Stokbridge" vibration dampers and applying able reinforcing to forty deadends on the 220 mile 132-kv. Boulder dam transmission line.

The work required the development of new technique and new tools for working the line while "hot." It required expert workmen and excellent engineering preparation to accomplish the feat. Boulder City residents did not experience any prolonged power lapses especially during the installation by the crew.
