

William Koontz Is Dead From Injuries

Passing away at 10 o'clock last night, William Koontz, truck driver injured in a fall from a truck several days ago, lost his battle against death, his demise being caused by gangrenous infection.

Koontz suffered extensive injuries to the pelvis when he struck a protrusion after being hurled from the cab of his truck by the locking of wheels of two trucks, the one he was driving and another.

When Koontz died his mother and two brothers, from Goldfield, as well as L. F. Detwiler of Goldfield and Miss Laura Kitchen of Los Angeles were present at Boulder hospital.

The young man was 24 years of age, and came from Goldfield about a year ago to work for Six Companies, living in one of the dormitories. He was well known and liked both in Goldfield and Boulder City. He had turned out for basketball early in the present season with the Boulder City Athletic club, and umpired the game played against the March Field team last Saturday. He suffered his injury the following day.

The body is at Parks mortuary in Boulder City and will be sent to Goldfield this afternoon for funeral services.
