

# Dam Lake Would Be Called Lake Nevada

WASHINGTON, D. C., Feb. 17.—  
(Special)—Senator Oddie today introduced a bill in the senate which would officially name the lake to be created by Boulder dam "Lake Nevada." It was referred to the committee on public lands. Oddie said that he expected action by congress at this session.

The bill provides that "the body of water resulting from the construction of Boulder Dam . . . shall be known and designated on the public record as Lake Nevada."

Section two of the bill states that "all records, surveys and maps and public documents of the United States, in which such body of water is mentioned or referred to shall refer thereto, under and by the name of Lake Nevada."
