

# High Scaler Dies

## In Fall off Cliff

Knocked off the bench by air hose which broke on the bench of the railroad tunnel Tom Markey, 35, high scaler, fell to his death yesterday afternoon at about 3 o'clock.

The air hose, leading to a jack hammer, broke and the loose end struck Markey so forcibly as to knock him off the edge. He is said to have fallen more than 200 feet to the bottom of the canyon.

Markey is survived by a wife and two children, who live in Long Beach, California.

Inquest into the death was held at 6 p. m. yesterday in Boulder City, under direction of Coroner Frank M. Ryan, and death was pronounced as brought about by accidental cause.
