

MAN WOUNDED IN DAM ROAD FRAY

George Harris, Resort
Cook, Stabbed Allegedly

Another crime of violence in the four mile area near the Boulder dam highway, was smeared on the records last night when George Harris, cook at the Blue Heaven dance hall, was taken to the Las Vegas hospital badly beaten and stabbed, allegedly by C. B. Irving, whom police say brags that he is a "three time loser."

The affray took place last night shortly after 9:30 and, police say, was occasioned by Harris attempting to save Ora Black, an entertainer at the establishment, from a severe beating at the hands of Irving.

Irving, according to police investigation, had said that he was going to kill the Black woman "before she learned too much" and he is said to have started in only to be confronted by Harris.

When Harris stepped into the fray, the report says, Irving whipped out a knife, stabbed Harris at least a dozen times and then slugged him over the head with an iron pipe.

Irving fled, after the affray police said, and was arrested in the Montana hotel, by Deputy Sheriff Bud Bodell.

At the hospital today, doctors said that Harris was not seriously injured but would be confined for at least a week with his wounds.

Irving, police said, told the Black woman that he was a three time loser and that he had been convicted once on a dope charge. His record is being checked, the officers said.
