

Accident Victim's Condition Serious

Condition of Jack McPhee, only one of the Boulder Dam trio to be seriously injured in his 100 foot plunge thru the spillway raise into diversion tunnel number 1 earlier in the week, is much more serious than was first believed, attending physicians said this morning.

McPhee's back is broken in several places, x-ray pictures revealed, and in addition the injured man has contracted pneumonia.

Latest reports were to the effect that his chest condition is clearing up, but his back will probably be in a cast for some time to come.

J. F. Armstrong is still in the hospital recovering from his injuries, and will be there for several days, attendants said. Wm Partain, the third member of the ill-fated trio, was released from the hospital yesterday.
