

# 2500 Visit Vegas Over the Holiday

Approximately 2,500 visitors thronged Las Vegas over the Labor Day holiday, according to figures prepared by Nye Wilson, secretary of the Las Vegas chamber of commerce.

All of the leading hotels were filled thruout the three day period, and all auto courts reported a full house, with some stating they were forced to turn away prospective tenants in large numbers.

A total of 2238 visitors in 762 automobiles passed by the reservation gates during the three days to view the Boulder dam project, with Saturday recording the highest total of 1167, in 386 automobiles.

Charleston Park reported a full house with 150 visitors over the week-end, while the government camps had 200 more.

It was estimated that approximately 2,000 were in attendance at Lorenzi Lake Resort for the Labor Day festivities yesterday.
