

Sibert Quits As Boulder Dam Critic

WASHINGTON, Nov. 1. (AP) — Major General William Sibert, retired army officer, has resigned as head of the board set up by congress to pass upon the technical plans for Boulder dam, it was revealed here today by the interior department, under whose jurisdiction the dam is being erected.

It was explained by officials of the department that the work of the board had been virtually completed and it was no longer necessary for General Sibert to give his time to the work.
