

Worker's Widow Seeking Damages

Asking compensation of \$5,000 for the death of her husband, Frank Manning, who died December 16, 1931, after he was injured while working at the Hoover dam, and also asking that all claims Ruby Manning may have to compensation be set aside, Mrs. Frances Manning filed suit in the federal court in Carson yesterday against the Nevada industrial commission, the Six Companies Inc., and Ruby Manning.

Mrs. Manning asks that either the Six Companies Inc., or the Nevada industrial commission pay her the compensation to which she says she is entitled as the wife of Frank Manning, who, she claims, died as the direct result of injuries received while working at the damsite. Ruby Manning has also claimed compensation, stating that she was married to Manning, but Frances Manning says the claim is not valid and asks that it be set aside.
