

# New Auto Bus Is Tried At Boulder

A monster motor transport bus, which is capable of hauling 150 men at a trip, is being tested out by Six Companies this week and, if proved satisfactory, will be put into service next Monday and orders for two more will be placed, according to Six Companies officials.

The new transport is a double deck affair, 10 feet wide, 13 feet high and 36 feet long and weighs 30,000 pounds. It was so large that it had to be shipped to Boulder City by rail because of weight limitations on California roads, the maximum load weight on those roads being 24,000 pounds.

The new transports, if satisfactory, will replace the old equipment and where some 15 trucks have been used in the past, but three of the new type will be necessary.

The trucks are made by the Standard Body Works of Los Angeles and are equipped with Mack A. P. Motors.
