

Anderson May U.A. Boulder Schools

Superintendent W. W. Anderson of the state department of public instruction, was a step nearer approving the Boulder City schools today, according to word received from Carson City.

Anderson has submitted a list of questions to Attorney-General Gray Mashburn and asked for a written opinion on each. If the opinions are satisfactory, Anderson indicated he would approve the establishment of a district in Boulder City immediately.

Attorney-General Gray Mashburn in a telephone conversation with Harry Gravelle, Boulder City leader, said he was scheduled to leave for Philadelphia today, but that he would remain in Carson until the school situation was definitely settled.
