

Boulder Carpenter Injured By Timber

Struck in the back by a falling timber, Claude A. Brown, carpenter for Six Companies Inc., suffered a dislocated hip and fracture of the left leg yesterday afternoon.

Brown was working in the Nevada spillway at about 2:30 p. m. when the accident occurred. He was rushed to the Boulder City hospital. He is suffering possible internal injuries, in addition to the fractured leg.
