

Dam Worker Hurt In Odd Accident

Bob Howard, Boulder dam worker, is in the hospital today with serious injuries about the head, and a possible skull fracture, as a result of a freak accident at the river last night.

Howard and a group of other men were working in the Arizona spillway when an eight yard bucket of cement suddenly dumped its contents to the earth, without warning.

The bucket swung badly in so doing, splattered the entire group with concrete, The rest of the men were able to clamber to safety, but Howard was caught beneath the shower and was injured.

Paul Smith, another workman, was less seriously hurt.
