

# BOOZE SUSPECT IS NABBED FOR 3RD TIME AT DAM

Jack Stanley Nabbed, Ac-  
cused of Hiring Others  
To Run Rum

Accused of hiring young dam workers to haul 48 pints of whiskey into Boulder City and store it in a dormitory room for him, Jack Stanley, previous offender, was arrested last evening by reservation police as he entered the room where the 48 pints had been stored.

He and Mrs. Stanley, who is said to have been seen helping load the whiskey into a machine near an establishment outside the reservation, are in jail in Boulder City today facing possible conspiracy charges, according to Police Chief G. E. Bodell.

Two officers waited in room 255, dormitory 8, where the whiskey had been secreted, from 2 o'clock yesterday afternoon until 10:45 p. m., at which time Stanley came off shift, where he works as high scaler, "hung around" the clubroom for awhile and then went to the room where the 48 pints had been placed by the young worker who assertedly hauled it through the gate.

**MRS. JACK Stanley** assertedly was seen handing the liquor to a young man, who loaded it into a car outside the reservation. After he had driven the whiskey through the gate and taken it to the room, the officers planted themselves in the room and waited. When Stanley entered eight hours later they arrested him, for the third time in Boulder City, and took him to jail.

Soon afterward, someone else, believed an accomplice, took Stanley's car and went off the reservation. Quizzed at the gate, he told officers Stanley had sent him on an errand with his car. Not long afterward, Mrs. Stanley appeared, driving the car, heading for the reservation. She was detained at the gate, however, and soon found herself in jail, despite her protestations of innocence.

**MR. AND MRS. STANLEY** have been under surveillance for three weeks, according to Chief Bodell.

It is said to have been Stanley who fired several shots at Dempsey Hale, at a joint just outside the reservation, some few months ago, in a dispute with the other man.
