

# Interior Secretary Aide Visits Dam

T. A. Walters, of Caldwell Idaho, first assistant secretary of the Interior, paid his first visit to the Boulder Canyon project this morning, arriving in Boulder City by automobile at 10:45, just in time to witness the pouring of the first batch of concrete on the job.

Walters was met at Salt Lake City by R. F. Walter, chief engineer of the Denver office of the Reclamation Bureau, and accompanied by Porter J. Preston, engineer in charge of upper basin investigations, and E. O. Larson, his assistant, left the Utah capital later yesterday afternoon for Boulder City.
