

Dam Workers Get Labor Day Layoff

According to a statement issued this morning by Frank T. Crowe, superintendent of construction for the Six Companies Inc., work on the Boulder Dam will be closed down from 7:30 o'clock Sunday morning, September 3, until 7:30 o'clock Tuesday morning, September 5.

The period of the shut-down will be forty-eight hours, and will involve Sunday, September 3, and Monday, September 4, according to Crowe.

Labor day is a government holiday, and the offices of the Bureau of Reclamation will be closed that day. Government crews in the canyon are to be granted the holiday.

According to M. J. Keough of the Babcock & Wilcock company, the plant will remain open on Labor day. Operations will not be suspended at the plant.
