

Reclamation Man Hurt In Car Crash

Halbert E. Anderson, reclamation bureau employe, narrowly escaped death early this morning when the auto he was driving from Boulder City failed to negotiate the turn on the dam highway near the Old Mill, turned over several times and was demolished.

No eye witnesses were available and Anderson could not recall the circumstances surrounding the crash, but it is believed that he lost control of the car while progressing at a high rate of speed.

The Las Vegas Funeral Home ambulance was sent to the scene of the wreck and Anderson was unconscious when it arrived, but he regained consciousness on the way to the hospital and there it was learned that he was not badly hurt.
