

Fund Lack Delaying Dam Exhibit Books

According to R. R. Russell, director of publicity for the chamber of commerce, the printing of 40,000 copies of appropriate literature to be taken to the Los Angeles county fair for distribution in connection with the showing of the working model of Boulder dam, has been held up pending the raising of more funds.

About one half the necessary funds have been raised and actually collected and it is very probable that another canvas of business houses will have to be made within the next day or two unless funds are forthcoming by that time. Boulder City has not been heard from but it is thought that their part will be forthcoming early next week.

In the meantime the working model of the dam is being rushed to completion at 106 South Second street where it may be seen by the public. The face of the dam was concreted yesterday by Superintendent Jack Albright "Crowe." Mike Silver has been foreman of all tunnel work.
