

Coast Companies Low On Dam Bid

DENVER, Colo., Sept. 9. (U.P.)—

A combination bid submitted by four California cement firms, was low for the next million barrels to be used on the Boulder Dam project, the figure, allowing for freight charges, being \$1,460,000.

The California combine consists of the Riverside Cement Company of Crestmore, Portland Cement Company of Colton, furnishing 300,000 barrels each, and the Southwestern Portland Cement Company of Victorville and the Monolith Portland Cement Company at Monolith, 250,000 barrels each.

The Pacific Portland Cement Company of San Francisco entered a bid of \$1.90 per barrel on its best grade of cement.
