

6 Companies Will Pay Taxes Soon

Six Companies' taxes and those of their subsidiary concerns within the Boulder dam reservation, will be paid as soon as attorneys for the contractors wire instructions to that effect, which will probably be within the next day or two, J. F. Reis, administration manager for the company at Boulder City, said this afternoon when informed by the Review-Journal that all actions pending in the federal court concerning the tax question within the reservation had been dismissed today.

This dismissal was part of the program agreed upon when the Clark county commissioners and the district attorney's office agreed on a compromise some weeks ago, and was ordered by Judge Frank H. Norcross after Attorney-General Gray Mashburn had filed a stipulation in which both the state and Six Companies agreed to a dismissal of the suit.

"We'll have the check ready within five minutes after we receive the word from our attorneys that all preliminary steps have been taken and the way is cleared," Reis said.

The total amount of the taxes to be paid is \$180,913.77.
