

# E. O. Wattis Is Elected President Of Six Companies Incorporated Today

E. O. Wattis, brother of W. O. Wattis, first president of Six Companies Incorporated, and himself one of the prime movers of the organization constructing Boulder dam, was today named president of the firm, to succeed the late Warren Bechtel.

Wattis, for the past several years associated with the Utah Construction company, is 78 years old and has been in the construction business nearly all his life.

The new president is quite well

known by the engineers and men on the Boulder dam, having been a visitor to the project on several occasions. He is vitally interested in the project and expects, according to information from Salt Lake to spend much more time in this area in the future.

Wattis is the third executive head of the organization which was formed to construct Boulder dam, his brother having been the first president and Bechtel the second.
