

Kingman-Dam Road Start To Be Observed

A big celebration, to observe the beginning of the highway from Boulder to Kingman, will be held when the first dirt is turned on construction, probably in the latter part of November, according to word received from Arizona today.

Governors of both Arizona and Nevada will be invited to attend as well as the residents of both states, particularly those of Mohave county in Arizona and Clark county, Nevada.

The movement was initiated by the board of supervisors of Mohave county and was given the unanimous endorsement of the Kingman chamber of commerce at its last meeting.

A special committee from the Kingman chamber of commerce and the county supervisors is working out plans for the event, and both Las Vegas and Boulder City chambers have been invited to join.

The present program calls for a free barbecue to be held at the Colorado river end of the road, from which point the highway to Kingman will start.

The first unit of the highway will be a three mile stretch leading back from the dam thru the rugged country that makes up the Arizona approach to the canyon. This is expected to be followed shortly by an additional ten mile stretch, according to advices from Kingman.
