

New Parking Regulations Are Sifted

New traffic regulations, as regards parking in the business district of Las Vegas, were drawn up yesterday afternoon by the city commission and will become effective as soon as signs can be erected in prominent places on the downtown streets. It was also ordered that the new regulations be strictly enforced.

Forty five minute parking will be the order from Main to Fifth street on Fremont and from Main to Fourth street, inclusive, between Carson and Ogden. The forty five minute parking, according to the officers, will not include Carson and Ogden, but merely the cross streets running into them.

Bus stops and loading zones, on Fremont street, will be removed and cars will be allowed to park anywhere, at the curb, on Fremont.

Angle parking will be in effect in the entire city with the exception of Fremont street, where the old parallel parking code will be ordered.

Four taxi stands, with one car apiece, were given stands on Fremont street while three transfer companies were granted stands on the side streets of the business district.

It is planned, if feasible, to reduce the minimum fine for traffic violations from three dollars to one dollar and some definite announcement as to the move will be made in the near future.

It was also decided to paint all boulevard stop signs red and white, to conform with those in the cities of California.
