

TIPS FOR TOURISTS

From the printing plant of the Las Vegas Evening-Review Journal will come soon, a tourist guide, "Scenic Short Trips From Las Vegas."

This guide will contain a 5x8 inch map of the Las Vegas area, made by Baker and Thompson, city engineers; illustrations of Boulder dam, Observation point, Charleston park, the Valley of Fire and the Lost city. It will show the auto routes, carefully detailed, from Las Vegas to Boulder dam, the Valley of Fire, the Lost city, Charleston park, Nob hill, Eldorado canyon, Gyp cave, Fort Callville and Death Valley. Extended descriptions of Las Vegas and Boulder dam will appear and briefer ones of each of the other interesting points mentioned.

The guide will be printed on gloss stock and in a size suitable for use in hotels, depots, cafes, bus stations, garages and service stations. It has been prepared at the request of local merchants and is to be distributed by them and thru the chamber of commerce to tourists here and sent to other cities over the country from which requests for such a guide are frequently being received. No doubt the guide will be of interest to many residents of Las Vegas and Boulder City, for it is a fact that a large percentage of them have not seen many of these intensely interesting scenic spots which are within a short distance of these cities.

The work of preparing this useful guide has been done by Roy Phillips and Merle J. O'Connor, with much assistance from Dr. W. S. Park, James Cashman, the chamber of commerce and others. Messrs. Phillips and O'Connor recently handled the new Las Vegas-Boulder City telephone directory, also printed in the Review-Journal plant.
